# How to answer ask-the-expert questions

## Finding questions to answer:

- 1. Go to the ask-the-expert forum at http://web4health.info/eu/kom/ask-the-expert-here;login
- 2. Give your login id and password, if you were not already logged in.
- 3. Under the heading **Draft discussions**: you will see a list of questions not yet answered.
- 4. If the Subject begins with a signature, for example "GP: " this indicates that another project partner is already working on an answer.
- 5. Select a question to answer, and click on its name, for example: **13696.** <u>sex guilt</u>, hemant, 01 Sep 21:39

## Handling delayed replies:

If you will not write your reply immediately, but want to work on it for some time, then do the following (Note: In principle there is nothing wrong with more than one person answering an ask-the-expert question. But of course, usually we can save time by not having two people answering the same question):

6. Add your signature at the start of the Subject, for example Gunborg Palme might add "GP: " at the start of the Subject:



- 7. Push the <u>Preview/save button</u> Now all other partners will see that GP is working on an answer to this query.
- 8. Note down the number of the question, in this case 13696. You can use this number in the future to locate the question, using the webb address: http://web4health.info/eu/kom/13696;login
- 9. When you are ready producing the text for your reply, locate the question to answer again, for example:

#### 13696. GP: sex guilt, hemant

- 10. Click on the subject above.
- 11. Remove the initial signature "GP: ".

#### Submitting the question and writing the reply:

- 12. Make, if needed, corrections to the language of the question.
- 13. Push the Submit button.



- 15. Write your answer.
- 16. Push the Submit button.
